

## **Town of Fairfield Select Board Minutes**

**September 12, 2016**

1. Brian Douglas came to discuss the sand shed design. The “Engineers Opinion of Probable Cost” significantly exceeds anticipated at \$531,977. Need to decide whether to find more money, change the size or scrap the plan. Several options discussed. State needs to review the plan prior to finishing the design. \$160K over anticipated cost. TH moves to continue. GC 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.
2. Maurice said all the blasting is done – some material at Havreluk’s pit. Paradee Rd is holding well after the rain. Need 1000 more yards of sand in Fairfield and 500 more in East.
3. Reviewed fuel bids from Collins, Joyal and Corse. MM to find out what Blouins is planning to charge next year.
4. Nice to see another pass with the mower now that it is repaired.
5. Extensive list of concerns from NRPC on Lazar Solar Project on North Rd.
6. Gene made a motion to approve the minutes of Aug. 8. Greg seconded. All in favor.
7. Errors and omissions from listers reviewed. Ok.
8. GMP has denied our permit for solar on the garage and fire station because we won’t consume enough of the power at those two buildings.
9. Sheriff coverage \$47/hour for coverage up to 10 days. Anything over that requires a contract. Sheriff reviewed our ordinances and said they are in good order and easy to enforce. Ask City and Town PD if they would like to quote.
10. Greg made a motion to approve the warrants and adjourn. Gavin seconded. All in favor.
