1. Greg made a motion to approve the minutes. Norm Seconded. All in Favor.
2. Tractor prices reviewed.
3. Security Alarm proposal reviewed. Smoke detectors and motion detectors change the price to \$1000 per building. Total cost \$4300 to install plus \$54.99/building per month to monitor. Could add DVR cameras that record but they are expensive to purchase and to install. Can also have cloud based live feed that can be viewed on a smart phone. GC moves to accept and install. Norm seconds. All in favor.
4. Weight permit signed.
5. Mower prices reviewed.
6. SunCommon has 3 new solar arrays – Magnan, Gaudette and Bushey. No permits required.
7. Board of Abatement on Oct. 13th prior to regular meeting. Fairfield Community Center and Judy and Roland Garceau who had a fire.
8. Cemetery tree quote from Jordan St. Pierre \$1000 to remove 3 large dead maples in Soule Cemetery. Ok to go ahead.
9. Bridge inspection report on Chester Arthur near Magnan. Needs repair. Will be complete prior to 12/31/14. Need to check with Rod about guardrail on the bridge.
10. Jim Smith called Tom about the culvert on Swamp. Continue to work on plans for next year.
11. Check the Brusco Rd approval. Amanda to look at Hazard Mitigation Grant approvals.
12. We have tires and rims for a dump truck that don't fit our trucks. Would we like to sell to RJ Branon? Also a piston that doesn't fit our trucks. Branons would like that too. Norm to come up with a price.
13. Ok to change sign providers.
14. Greg made a motion to approve the warrants. Norm seconded. All if favor.
15. Ok for MM to use the Park&Ride lot for Turn Off Texting Demo on October 2nd.
16. Issue with Chester's tank/pipe for grease trap discussed.
17. Greg made a motion to adjourn. Tom seconded. All in favor.
